## **RESOLUTION NO. 9-2022**

## AN RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT TO JOIN THE HOUSTON-GALVESTON AREA COUNCIL COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM AND TO CONTRACT WITH FOREVER LAWN OF NORTHERN OHIO TO PURCHASE PLAYGROUND TURF AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Marblehead Council, upon recommendation of its Parks Committee, has determined to upgrade James Park with new equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Marblehead Council has determined as part of the upgrade of the equipment new turf is needed under and around the equipment; and

WHEREAS, Forever Lawn of Northern Ohio has submitted a quote to supply the turf; and

WHEREAS, Forever Lawn is a member of the Houston-Galveston Area Council purchasing cooperative; and

WHEREAS, the Village desires to join that cooperative in order to get the best price for the turf.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MARBLEHEAD, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1:</u> The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract to join the Houston-Galveston Area Council for cooperative purchasing.

<u>Section 2:</u> The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute any documents required with Forever Lawn of Northern Ohio to obtain the turf for James Park.

Section 3: This Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of Council, and of its committees, which result in formal action, were taken in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements.

<u>Section 4:</u> This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the Village of Marblehead, and for the further reason that the contracts need to be entered into immediately to obtain the best price and therefore this Resolution shall go into immediate effect.
